COURSES

What kind of course do we organise?

As well as our usual Courses for Students, ANGLIA now offers a Brand New Course for Teachers of English as a Second/ Foreign language.

By the end of the course, teachers will have updated their English, shared experiences with other international teachers and learnt teaching skills from both their course tutors as well as other course participants.

How long does this course last?

The duration of this course is two weeks. There is a possible extension of one further week, totalling three weeks.

How many hours of study does this course offer?

This course will take place Monday to Friday, with five full mornings & four afternoons; total hours per week are 21.

Is there a minimum age/ experience to attend this course?

This course is exclusively aimed at adult teachers of English, although no minimum experience is necessary.



ACCOMMODATION

Where will participants stay?

All participants will stay at Westgate Halls of Residence, within Chichester College Campus, and will have all meals included.
All bedrooms are single, and have an en-suite bathroom. A kitchen is also available for residents' use.



SOCIAL PROGRAMME

What trips will participants go on?

Both Anglia UK and the Local Representatives offer visits to different places of touristic & cultural interest within the UK. Some of the cities we usually visit include Brighton, Portsmouth, London, Winchester, Oxford, Arundel, Bath, Stonehenge, Windsor, the New Forest. These visits might be full-day, half-day or weekend excursions, and participants will always be accompanied by, at least, one group leader.

What social activities are promoted in the afternoons/evenings?

The Local Representatives organise many afternoon & evening activities, such as pubs, bowling, nightclubs, cinema, theatre, student/ teacher parties, restaurant dinners, walking tours, shopping trips, etc.

TRAVEL INSURANCE

It is mandatory to have travel/ medical insurance to enter the United Kingdom - it may be issued by:

- ✓ Credit Card companies
- ✓ Medical Insurance companies in own country
- ✓ Private providers of travel insurance, such as: UNIVERSAL ASSISTANCE, ASSIST CARD, etc.



EXTRA MONEY

We recommend extra/ pocket money to the amount of USD 1.100 for two weeks. It might be partially covered with credit/ debit cards.



PAYMENT METHODS

Total to be paid: COURSE + ACCOMMODATION + (OPTIONAL WEEKEND IN LONDON)

Booking fee: USD 300

This fee will be discounted from the total to be paid.

a. Course + Accommodation: The remainder may be paid in instalments after the booking fee is received. It may be paid in cash, through bank deposit/ transfer and/ or by credit/ debit card.

b. OPTIONAL WEEKEND IN LONDON: should you wish to join the group for this weekend, this amount will be paid in cash, to the Group Leader, once in Chichester.

NOTE: All outstanding amounts must, at the latest, be cancelled 30 days before the date of departure.



INFORMATION MEETINGS

The Local Representatives organise information sessions before the trip, so that travellers can get to know one another, meet their Group Leader(s), and clear all their doubts before the trip.

HOW DO I SIGN UP?

The first step is to pay the booking fee and email us the transaction slip, together with your full name & date of birth.
